The Linda Davis YCLA consists of events designed to expose participants to leaders from all industry segments. These events include the Joint Stockman's Convention, the legislative session in Santa Fe, educational field day tours, the Mid-Year Meeting, and quarterly educational zoom calls. The seminars will allow participants to explore the cattle business further, gain crucial information, and network with fellow NMGCA members. After graduation from the program, participants have the opportunity to interview for the NCBA Young Cattlemen's Conference.
